

## OVERVIEW OF THE TRAINING PROGRAMMES OFFERED BY THE ISIDORE PARTNERS

The ISIDORe partners and their collaborators offer a broad portfolio of training opportunities that are consistent with, but not limited to, the ISIDORe objective of enhancing European and global capacity to prevent and respond to infectious threats. The training offers range from (on demand) on-site and/or virtual training, workshops, conference sessions and webinar series, to written guidelines. Many providers have their own training platform, which allows, for example, self-paced learning and/or access to recordings of training content. Further detailed information can be found on the websites of the ISIDORe partners as well as the World Health Organization (WHO), the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) and the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH).

The platform also intends to help stakeholders and the public sector to understand the innovations and risks of infectiology experimentation, the best practices, the use of international standards and to illustrate current and likely changes in disease outbreak control.  VetBioNet works in partnership with the International Veterinary Biosafety Workgroup (IVBW), a 167 members organisation involved in farmed animal high containment from across the world, with a mission to promote best practice in microbiological biocontainment and safety in veterinary laboratories that have national responsibility for the health of large animals, and which operate at BSL3 and 4. VetBioNet has a page on the IVBW for sharing its outputs on best practice guidance notes.
